WHAT IS TITLE I?

Title I is a federally funded program in which money is allocated to schools that meet specific guidelines to provide services that strive to raise academic achievement.

TITLE I - MRSD

~The Monadnock Title I program is funded at \$ 477,108 for 2022-2023 school year.

~Title I Schoolwide Programs are provided at Cutler, Emerson, and Troy Elementary schools. This program allows services to be provided to all students at the school that need extra support to meet the state academic standards.

~Title I Targeted Assistance Program is provided at Monadnock Regional Middle School for students grades 7 & 8. These students meet specific requirements, those who are failing, or at risk of failing to meet the state's standards.
