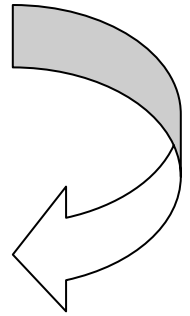

**Accompanying the Social Expectations #4. Creating a climate based on trust and decency, and #5 Using appropriate interpersonal skills, you are expected to:**

- **Enter class on time** and sit in your assigned seat. The handbook regulations regarding tardiness to class are used consistently.
- **Always** do the best you can, treat people the way you want to be treated, and don't be rude. Remove your hat when entering this classroom.
- **Come to class fully prepared** daily with your math book, assignment book, notebook, pencils, and homework. **PENCILS** are required.
- **Write all assignments neatly** and use a full sheet of paper, unless otherwise directed.
- Write your **full name, the date, and the assignment** on each paper you hand in to me. Be sure to follow the form given to you on the back of the grading policy sheet. The format is also on a large poster in the classroom.
- Keep your **textbook covered**.
- Leave phones and MP3 players **OUT** of the classroom. The handbook regulations will be followed.

## Other Important Items:

You are expected to use the bathroom during your 4 minutes between classes, not during class time. **If you do have an emergency**, a quiet word to me will be an appropriate signal that you need to leave. Always ask first! **Passes** to the health office will be given only if there appears to be an emergency. Please wait until I am done with the daily lesson or another student when possible. Sign out on the clipboard whenever leaving the room; sign in when returning. There will be no permission given to retrieve items from your locker.

**Homework** will be assigned before the end of class each day. It will be written on the board during class for you to copy, and will be posted on the school website by the end of the day. The homework is due completed the next day, unless otherwise directed. I will not always collect it but expect it completed and in your notebook. If you have difficulty completing an assignment I will gladly help you with it after school. Work not completed as directed will be graded as zero for the remainder of the quarter. **Unless you have been absent or are after school with me, work will not be accepted late.**

You will have **one week to MAKE UP homework, a quiz, or test that you missed** or on which you would like to try to do better. *After the one-week limit you will not be allowed to make up the work.* You are not allowed to do this work for credit unless you stay after school with me. **If you are absent be sure to ask me about work you missed and hand it in according to the rules in the school handbook.**

You must have a **1 ½ inch 3-ring binder** that will contain all of your notes, handouts, and homework. It may be graded periodically during any quarter. You may be allowed to use your notebook for reference on some quizzes, tests, and exams. Four dividers will be helpful.

**SCIENTIFIC CALCULATORS and geometry tools** (straight edge/ruler, compass, protractor) will be helpful for you to bring to class daily even though you may not be using them every day or for every assignment.

A **quiz or test** will be given at least once a week. Daily review quizzes may be given without advanced notice. A midterm and final exam will also be given, and their scores recorded on your report card.

Keep the **textbook that you sign for** at the beginning of the school year. If it is lost let me know as soon as possible. It must be paid for before you can receive another book. If you owe money from last year you will be able to use a book in class only.
